CRITERIA

Applicant must:

- Be a fellow (post-residency) or in last two years of residency at time of 2025 Annual Meeting | April 9 - 13, 2025
- Be the presenter of a podium or poster presentation at the 2025 Annual Meeting
- Be involved in an American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery or American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery approved residency program in the [MAOA 20-state region](#)
- Be a United States citizen or have applied for US Citizenship
- Recipient must attend the MAOA Annual Meeting and the Wednesday, April 9, 2025 Pre-Course Meeting. If recipient is unable to attend the pre-course, the grant dollar amount will be reduced by \$500
- Possess strong ethical and moral standards and have the potential to be a contributing member of the Mid-America Orthopaedic Association.

SUBMISSION

Include the following:

- 500 – 1000 word essay covering the following:
 - Your role in the research project
 - What you hope to get out of the 2025 MAOA Annual Meeting
 - Future career plans
- Curriculum vitae
- Signed letter (by program director) indicating you are in good standing and able to attend the 2025 MAOA Annual Meeting | April 9 - 13, 2025

The MAOA Board of Directors requires that a staff consultant who co-authors your paper be present at the annual meeting to respond to any questions that arise during discussion. Please notify your staff consultant of this prior to grant application submission.

Former recipients of any MAOA Education Grant are not eligible to apply
