Applicant must:

- Be in his/her first five years of practice at time of 2024 Annual Meeting | April 10 - 14, 2024
- Be a member of MAOA or have applied for membership
- Have completed an American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery or American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery approved orthopedic residency
- Maintain practice within the [MAOA 20-state region](#)
- Be a United States citizen or have applied for U.S. citizenship
- Recipient must attend the MAOA Annual Meeting and the Wednesday, April 10, 2024 Pre-Course Meeting. If recipient is unable to attend the pre-course, the grant dollar amount will be reduced by \$500.
- Possess strong ethical and moral standards and have the potential to be a contributing member of the Mid-America Orthopaedic Association
