TO ATTEND MAOA 39TH ANNUAL MEETING

\$2,500 Education Grants are available for senior residents* or fellows to attend the 2022 MAOA Annual Meeting

Criteria for Application – Applicant must:

1. Be a fellow (post-residency) or in last two years of residency at time of 2022 Annual Meeting: April 6 – 10, 2022
2. Be the presenter of a podium or poster presentation at the 2022 Annual Meeting
3. Be involved in an American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery or American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery approved residency program in the MAOA 20-state region
4. Be a United States citizen or have applied for U.S. citizenship
5. Recipient must attend the MAOA annual meeting and the Wednesday, April 6, 2022 pre-meeting course meeting to receive the award. If the recipient is unable to attend the pre-meeting course, the grant dollar amount will be reduced by \$500.
6. Possess strong ethical and moral standards and have the potential to be a contributing member of the Mid-America Orthopaedic Association

Former recipients of education grants to attend MAOA annual meetings are not eligible

Applicant must submit:

1. Completed application form
2. Letter of intent specifying the goals of attendance at the annual meeting and the expected benefits to be realized by the applicant and their institution
3. Curriculum vitae
4. Letter of reference from your Orthopedic Residency Program Director

*Last two years of residency

Please be advised that these funds may be considered taxable income. It is recommended that a tax accountant be consulted on this matter.
